Criteria for scholarship are as follows.

U. S. Steel Serbia d.o.o Sons & Daughters Scholarship

Objective

Awards

The U.S. Steel Serbia Scholarship program would provide [6] 1,000 EUR awards that cover extra expenses such as trips abroad, computer equipment, books etc.

These awards would be given annually.

Eligibility

The U.S. Steel Serbia Scholarship program is limited to sons and daughters of active, full-time employees of U.S. Steel Serbia d.o.o

Sons/daughters include natural children, step-children, and legally adopted children.

Employees include management and union-represented.





Selection Criteria

The scholarship will be given to students based on academic performance, financial need and leadership qualities.

Students studying in the faculties of Engineering, Accounting and Finance and Law will be given priority, but any student is encouraged to apply.

Acceptance of the U.S. Steel Serbia Scholarship will not obligate the recipient to employment with U.S. Steel Serbia, nor will it obligate U.S. Steel Serbia to offer employment to the recipient.

Timetable

Students must apply for scholarships July 20. Awards will be announced September 15.

How to Apply

Application forms will be available on the U. S. Steel Serbia intranet and Public Affairs Web Page. Official announcement will be given in the Steel Monthly.

University of Belgrade committee will evaluate applications and choose recipients.

Termination

If the recipient fails to attend full time or is suspended by his/her college for academic or disciplinary reasons, future applications of students will not be considered.
